RESPONSIBILITIES	 Provide for the strategic planning and oversight of the development of scope of practice statements and standards of nursing practice Review and make recommendations for recognition of a nursing specialty, approval of the specialty nursing scope of practice statements, acknowledgment of the standards of specialty nursing practice, and affirmation of focused practice competencies.
	 Monitor current and future healthcare environments for the development, implementation, and approval and acknowledgment of nursing practice standards to promote safe, quality and evidence- based healthcare practice and policy.
TERM OF OFFICE	Four (4) years or until a successor is appointed; alternates hold 2-year appointments
TERM LIMIT	Two (2) consecutive 4-year terms
TIME COMMITMENT	 At a minimum, one (1) two-hour committee conference call each month Average of two to three hours a month reading informational materials and reviewing specialty scope and standards documents One (1) two-day in person meeting per year Travel time to the in-person meeting
QUALIFICATIONS	 Individual membership in a C/SNA or IMD of ANA throughout the period of service on the committee. No conflict of interest with the work of the committee. Previous experience with developing, implementing, or evaluating standards and/or active involvement in related activities. Knowledge of policymaking at the state and/or national level. Previous ANA/C/SNA/IMD activity. Access to electronic resources mandatory, organizations or peer networks preferable. Affirmation of commitment to prepare for and actively participate in all committee and small group activities.
